LOCATION



The hotel is in walking distance of all the main sites including the Arab Baths, Santa Clara Convent, s'Hort del Rei and Almudaina Palace. The attractive Parc de la Mar is on its doorstep leading visitors along the old city wall. It's not just history which can be found here. Peruse art galleries along Sant Feliu, designer shops at Sant Nicolau and enjoy the restaurants of La Lonja and nightlife at Santa Catalina.

RELAX & ENJOY

Hotel El Llorenç has the only infinity pool with a sea view in Palma.

Reliable sunshine and brilliant blue sky are two of Mallorca's greatest gifts and can be fully enjoyed in the peace of their Mediterranean terrace and cocktail bar.

Away from the sun the Ç Wellness Studio is the place to restore a sense of wellbeing. SLEEP


